In short I am seeking any paperwork/information in regards to what has been a long-standing policy of the Department of Immigration (now WORC) in regards to the waiver of adverts for unskilled temporary work permits.

As far back as I can remember (2007) this has been a policy of the department. However, it is not known whether this was a directive by Cabinet or a policy of the Department. I am working with Kim from the Cabinet office however, to date she has not found such a directive.

Would either of you be able to provide any information at all regarding this policy especially when it came into effect and whether it was a department policy or a directive from Cabinet.
